The church organised campaign and programme in religious matter. The campaign called Saninhringna (Salvation) campaign, had been successfully organised when Rev. P.C. Lura Darnei begun his pastoral ministry in Tang bial in the year 1989. The emerging theology called 'born-again' was first introduced by Rev. Lura in Hrangkhol area.⁷⁴

The church also recently organised a leadership conference called Upa (elder) Conference. It is usually met once in a year at Presbytery level. The PWF also organised a seminar annually. The conference and seminar provide a better knowledge in Christian education.

Christianity came to the Hrangkhol areas at a time when British exercised a big trade in N.C. Hills. So people preferred trade rather than becoming Christians. In the mean time the Gospel was preached at a crucial time when the Hrangkhols priests and prophets were practising divination, sorcery, etc. They live with many kinds of beliefs and practices. For this reason, planting the Gospel was very late. Inspite of opposition and persecution the Gospel flourished in Hrangkhol area during the fourth decade of 20th century. However, Christianity spread slowly. Now there are approximately 70% Hrangkhol Christians in North Cachar Hills in Assam.
