Christians living in Christians villages could not preserved their traditional religion properly.

With the coming of Christianity, Hrangkhol society was transformed physically, spiritually and intellectually. It was Christianity that provided a new models which enable the Hrangkhol Christians to accommodate themselves into the new order of society. When they embraced Christian Faith, beliefs in the existence of numerous gods were abandoned since Christianity is proclaimed one transcendental God. The traditional customs and practices are now performed in the frame-work of Christian rites. Christianity contributes a new sense of unification of society, integrated community and identity through the creation of written literature, through it s ideology as well as through its ecclesiastical structure. Besides, Christianity rajse the position of women. In pre-Christian days, women are sub-ordinated and secluded in religious matter. After becoming Christians, women are now provided to play a new role within the Church as well as in public leadership. In short, Christianity has awaken the Hrangkhol tribes to a new life-style both in spiritual and material spheres.
